Long Term Care Shopping Tips

- Shop around for an insurance agent and an insurance company--ask friends, family or neighbors if they recommend their insurance agent or company--then compare *several* different products from *several* different insurance companies.
- Carefully compare the benefits and restrictions between policies.
- Evaluate whether premium payments over a long period would be a financial hardship.
- Never pay insurance premiums in cash; do not make checks payable to the insurance *agent*.
- Read your policy carefully and ask follow up questions.
- Use your "Free Look" period to return a policy for a full refund if you are not satisfied.
